- ◆ Government is bad

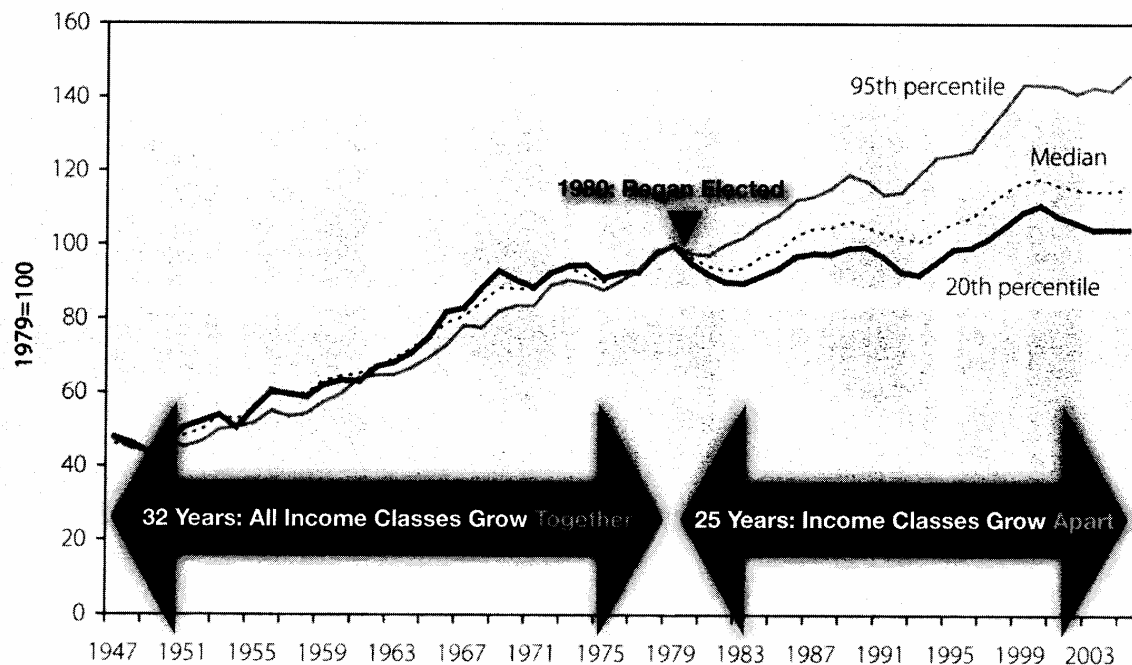

Last 25 years:

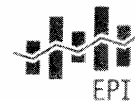
Top 5%: + 44%

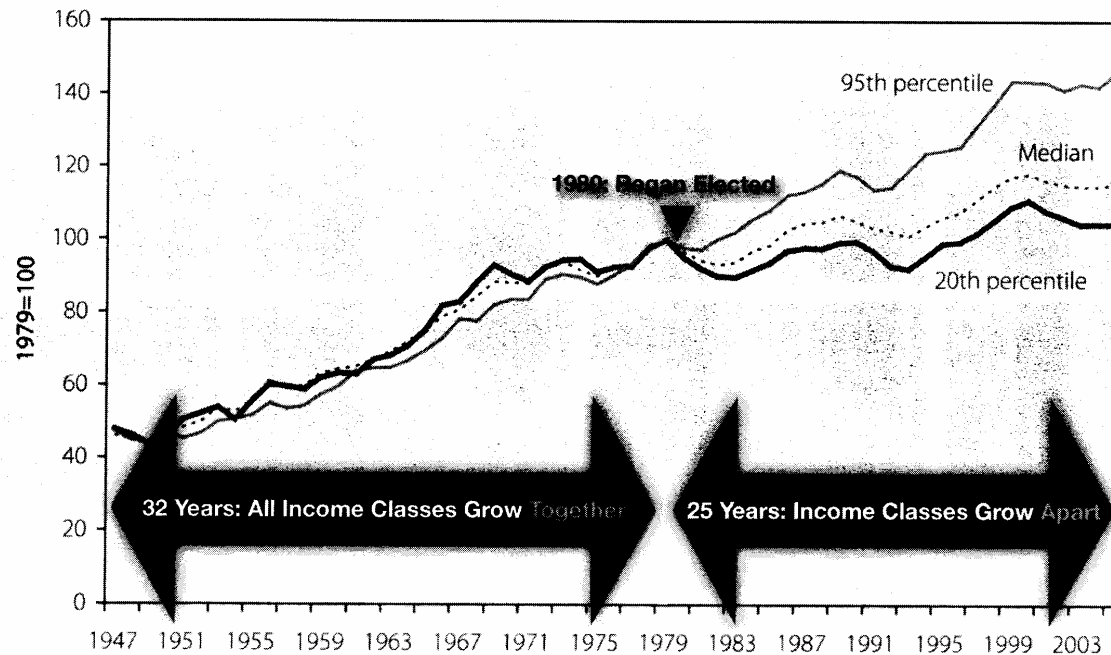

Umatilla County situation

Increasingly competitive races

- ◆ Democrats here do much better than registration predicts
Umatilla County: 13.2k R — 9.4k D — 7.1k not affiliated
- ◆ Republicans have an registration edge, yet ...
many council members and mayors are Dems
- ◆ BUT it is the non-affiliated voters who hold the keys
to elect office-holders and pass ballot measures here

- ◆ Begin weekly cable
- ◆ Launch large / monthly
donor program / Online
donations

Building the party

Helping candidates — beginning

- ◆ Raise a farm team and “candidate seed fund” to help local candidates move up the funding ladder
- ◆ Matching funds at different tiers as candidate campaigns meet criteria (voter contacts, funds raised, etc.)
- ✓ Provide candidates access to VoteBuilder
- ◆ Provide campaign assistance
- ◆ Raise visibility of Republican failures to govern well in Umatilla County (the Smith’s, Nelson, Jensen)

Building the party — status
